Other lessons I've learned:

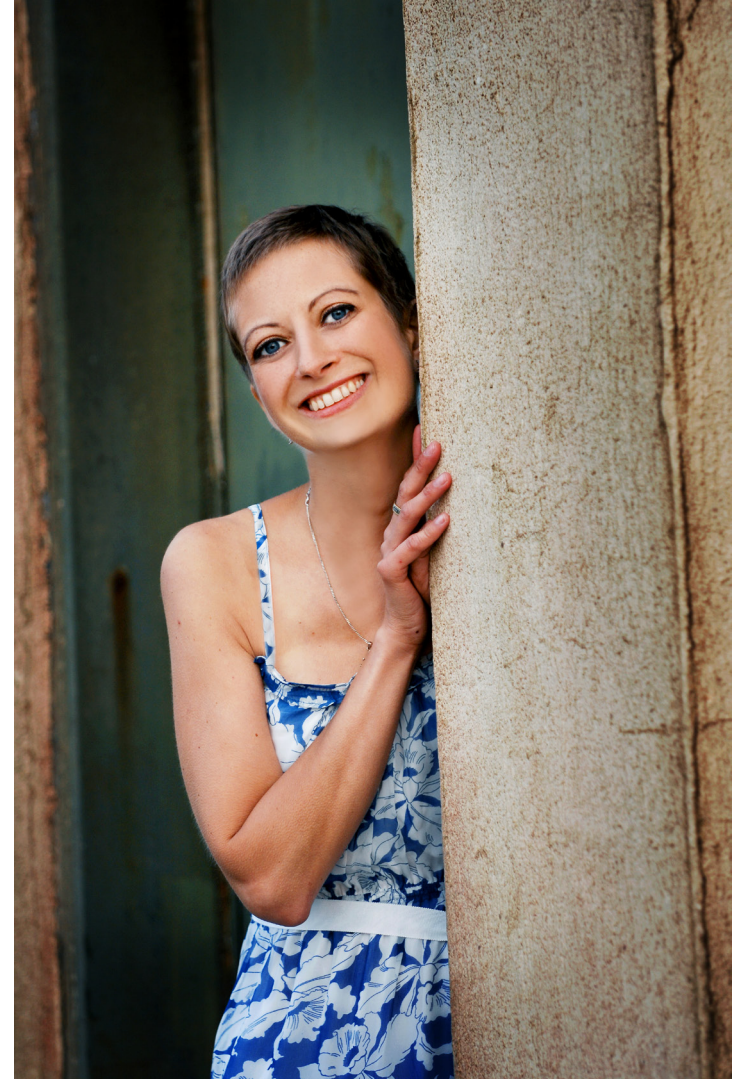
Love each other
